Why use the School-Based Health Center?

The School-Based Health Center (SBHC) is a private, safe place for high school students to receive medical, dental, and mental health care. The Health Center is open extended hours, so students can access services at any time while on campus.

Services at the SBHC are provided at no cost to families, whether or not you have insurance. SBHC bills private insurance and accepts Apple Health when available. Families will not receive a bill for service costs above insurance coverage. Students without insurance can also be seen at the SBHC without receiving a bill.

How can students make an appointment?

Students need their parent or guardian to complete an SBHC Registration packet to enroll in the SBHC. Packets can be picked up at the high school office or be completed online.

Once the SBHC has a completed registration packet on file, students can request an appointment by emailing SBHC@chcsno.org.

For urgent issues, student also can go to the school nurse or come directly to the clinic's waiting area. The staff will reach out to the parent or guardian via phone for consent.

Students enrolled in the SBHC can access confidential reproductive or mental health services at the SBHC, according to Washington state's minor consent laws. These services are available to minors in any healthcare clinic in the community.
