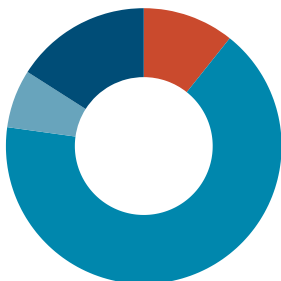

**HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2025**

- Filled nearly 200,000 prescriptions for over 25,000 patients, ensuring consistent access to essential medications.
- Delivered nearly 10,000 telehealth visits, expanding access through convenient, remote care.
- Cared for nearly 8,000 individuals that lack housing, double the previous year and a significant step forward in reaching those with the greatest barriers to healthcare.
- Partnered with Everett Public Schools to open two new school-based health centers, bringing vital health services directly to students.
- Provided nearly 12,000 immunization visits, helping protect community health and prevent the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases.
- 40% of CHC employees speak a language other than English, ensuring care is culturally appropriate and our employees reflect our community.

- 16% Private Insurance

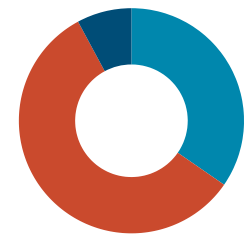
We provided interpretation for **89** languages to more than **21,000** patients in 2025.
